

## WILD BUNCH CATEGORY REQUIREMENTS

March and October Matches at KC's Corral

Optional category - all SASS categories will also be available

Shooter should be dressed as a turn-of-the-century working cowboy or military personnel from Spanish-American War through Mexican Border Excursions to WWI. Military and cowboy gear may be mixed.

Shooter **MUST** use at least one **non-SASS legal**, pre-1919 pistol or revolver, caliber .32 or larger, firing solid lead bullets. Examples include: Webley Mark IV or V, S&W pocket hammerless, Colt Lightning, Hopkins & Allen Safety Police, Bodeo M1889, Webley Bulldog, Colt New Army, Lebel 1892, Nagant Double Action 1895, Smith & Wesson (or Colt) 1917, Luger, Mauser "Broomhandle," Browning 1910/1912, Bergman/Bayard, Browning/Colt 1903, or Colt 1911 (standard model 1911A1 is ok, but no adjustable sights, compensators, ambidextrous safeties, synthetic frames, double-stack magazines, etc...)

Shooter may either use a second such gun, a second gun that is SASS legal, or an on the clock reload with a magazine, stripper clip, or half moon clip; or one-by-one. No speedloaders.

Shooter will load any pistol or revolver with five rounds, hammer or striker down on an empty chamber, EXCEPT in the case of a 5-shot double-action revolver, which may be loaded with five rounds, no matter where the hammer rests.

Each pistol must be safely carried in a holster.

Shooter may use any shooting style (traditional, duelist, or gunfighter), throughout the match.

Shooter **MAY** use any shotgun, including SASS legal ones, that is pre-1919. Examples include: Winchester 1893, Winchester Model 12, Browning A5, Winchester 1897 Trenchgun, or other pre-1919 pumps, autos or doubles. Shooter is restricted to no more than two rounds in the gun at a time.

Shooter must ensure that all guns are in safe working order with modern ammunition.

Shooter **MUST** use a SASS-legal main match rifle.
